You may be eligible for the research study **Mechanisms of oxidative stress during N-Acetyl Cysteine (NAC) supplementation in Veterans with Gulf War Illness (GWI)** with Dr. Wes Ashford to address symptoms associated with deployment in **Operations Desert Storm and Desert Shield**



Gulf War Illness Clinical Trials and Interventions Center

You may be eligible if you:

- Served in the Gulf War theater for any period between August 1990 and July 1991
- Are between 47-70 years old
- Have Gulf War illness symptoms:
 - Attention/memories difficulties
 - Unexplained fatigue
 - Headaches
 - Mood and sleep disorders
 - Joint and muscle pain
 - Gastrointestinal complaints

If you qualify:

- You will be asked to complete online surveys and tests, and attend scheduled blood draws at your local site laboratory
- Once enrolled, you will participate in a 16 week study where you will receive supplement therapy of NAC or a placebo
- Participants will be eligible for compensation
