


# Brain Imaging Research Study



**We are recruiting healthy participants as well as patients for a research study conducted at the Palo Alto VA Medical Center. Participants can be Veterans or non-Veterans. This study uses state-of-the-art Magnetic Resonance Imaging (MRI) to measure brain structure and function.**

## **Eligible Participants:**

- Males and females between the ages of 18 and 75.
- To be eligible, you must be deemed safe to participate in an MRI experiment (no metal in your body, claustrophobia, etc.).
- Patients with current or history of neurological, psychiatric disorders, or traumatic brain injury are encouraged to participate.

Participation will last approximately 2.5 hours (~1 hour of MRI scans, plus additional time for computerized testing/questionnaires). You will be compensated for your time.
