The Level 2 Military Environmental Exposures Certification Program advances clinical knowledge on commonly reported military environmental exposures through case-based learning. This certification is available to those who successfully complete the Level 1 certification.



About the Program

This program consists of 10 modules, each tailored to a specific military environmental exposure and related medical concerns.

Program content includes:

- Vietnam and Agent Orange Health Concerns
- Airborne Hazards and Open Burn Pit Exposures
- Gulf War I Service and Non-Gulf War Illness Conditions
- Ionizing Radiation and Health Concerns for Veterans
- Toxic Embedded Fragments and Depleted Uranium
- ...and more

Each module includes required readings or videos, a lecture with case studies or examples and a post-module test. Resource materials are provided to support you as you care for Veterans.

As you go through the program, you will:

- * Develop an advanced understanding of various military environmental exposures and related health concerns.
- * Learn how to treat Veterans from the lens of exposure-informed care.
- * Acquire the tools that health care professionals need to respond to Veterans with military exposure concerns.

Those who successfully complete all course components will receive 10.5 CEU credits.
